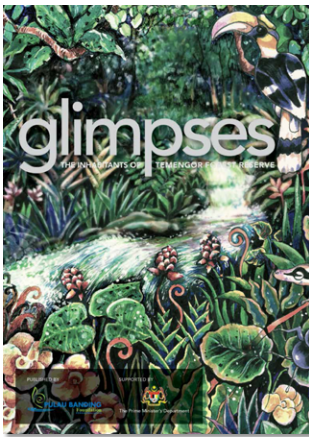

Belum Rainforest Summit (BRainS 2016)

17-22 October 2016 |
Pulau Banding, Gerik, Perak



INTRODUCTION

For the first time Pulau Banding Foundation (PBF) in collaboration with the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (NRE), Perak State Government, Malaysian Timber Council (MTC), Forest Research Institute Malaysia (FRIM), Malaysian Nature Society (MNS) and Belum Conservation Malaysia has successfully organised the Belum Rainforest Summit 2016 or BRainS 2016 in short from the 17th – 22nd October 2016. The Summit was supported by a renowned international forestry research organisation - the International Union of Forest Research Organisation (IUFRO) based in Vienna, Austria and the Ministry of Tourism and Culture Malaysia and the Malaysian Convention and Exhibition Bureau (MyCEB).

The main theme of the Summit was "Towards a Sustainable Forest Ecosystem through Research, Corporation and Networking". The Summit was officially launched by Prof. Madya Dr. Ramzah Dambul, Deputy Secretary General of the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI) representing the Honourable Minister.

The major sponsor for the Summit was EMKAY Group. Additional sponsorships were also received from the Perak State Government, Malaysian Timber Council (MTC) and MyCEB.

BRAIN S 2016—THE OBJECTIVES AND THEMES

BRainS 2016 was organised with these specific objectives:

1. To bring together practitioners of tropical forest management of the Amazon, Congo and Asia to share their experiences.
2. To encourage all researchers and stakeholders in the tropical regions of the world to share their knowledge and best practices in forestry and related sciences.
3. To promote conservation of nature and the natural environment in all tropical rainforest continents.
4. To promote the tropical rainforest complex as eco-tourism destinations.
5. To develop long-term networks for sharing experiences and
6. To showcase the experiences of PBF in the management of tropical forest biodiversity.

The following main themes were discussed during the Summit:

1. Biodiversity conservation and restoration
2. Tackling climate change issues
3. Global funding opportunities
4. Payment of ecosystem services and
5. Green and sustainable investment

Five keynote speakers, 13 speakers by invitation and 42 oral presentations were deliberated within the five-day Summit covering the 5 main themes.

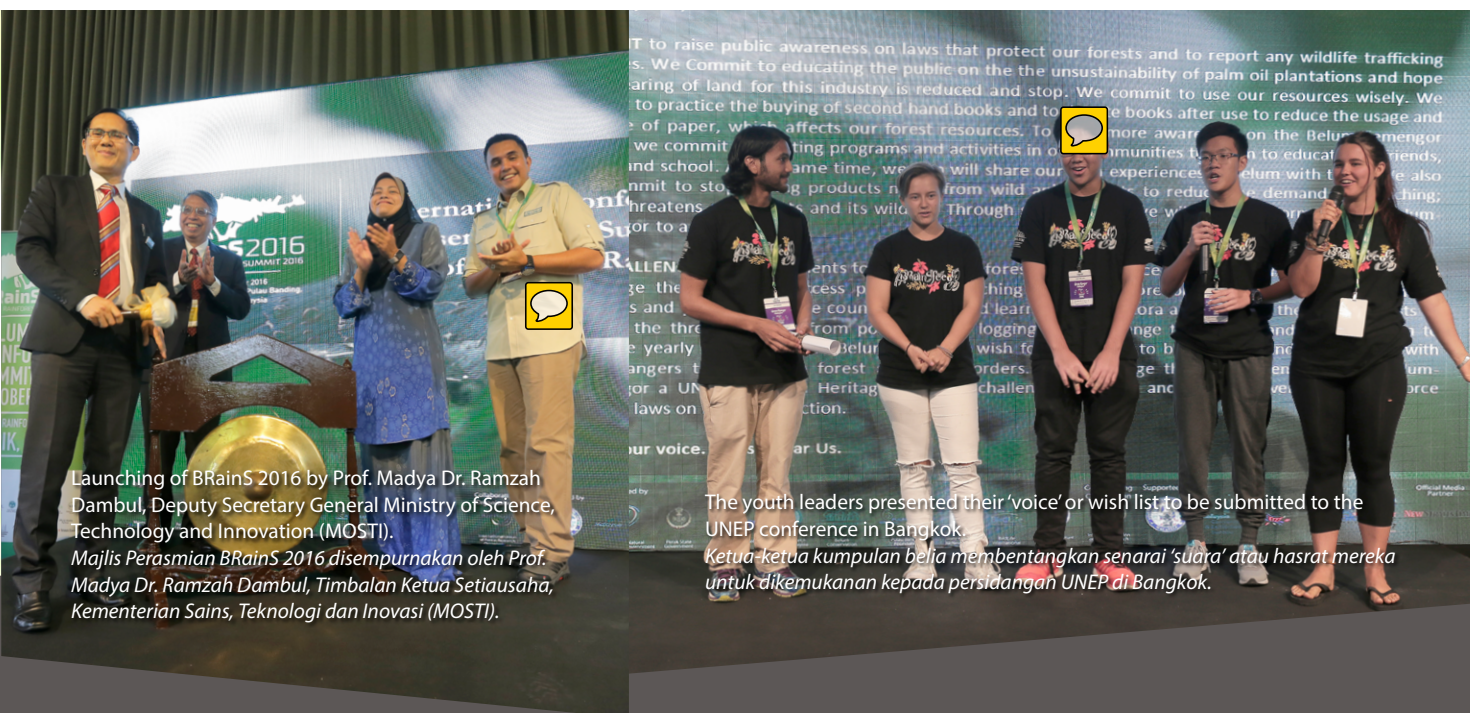
The keynote speakers were Prof. Tan Sri Dr. Zakri Abdul Hamid, Science Advisor to the Prime Minister of Malaysia, Prof. Dr. Michael Wingfield, President of IUFRO, Prof. Dr. Richard Murphy, Director of Centre of Environmental Strategic, University of Surrey, United Kingdom, Dato' Sri Dr. Abdul Rahman Abd. Rahim, Director General, Forestry Department Malaysia and Dr. Jenny Wong, Programme Officer, Mitigation, Data and Analysis Programme of United Nation Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCC).

Prof Dr. Michael Wingfield talked about building sustainable forest ecosystems; Prof Dr. Richard Murphy spoke about global funding opportunities for conservation; Martin Hollands, a senior advisor of BirdLife International shared his research on how changing economic models affected forest management; Manoj Gautam, Executive Director of the Jane Goodall Institute of Nepal, shared his case studies on successful conservation efforts in Nepal; and Dr. Jenny Wong, emphasised on the crucial role played by forests in climate change mitigation.

With many interesting presentations, the Summit had created a very good atmosphere for discussion, interaction and networking.

THE PARTICIPANTS

The Summit was held at the Belum Rainforest Resort, Pulau Banding, Gerik, Perak and was attended by 107 conservationists, policy makers, scientists, academia, eco-tourism industries, forestry administration and managers, government officials, NGOs and indigenous community from 12 different countries including Cambodia, Canada, Ghana, Germany, Indonesia, Nepal, Philippines, Republic of Czech, Singapore, United Kingdom, USA and Vietnam.

THE BELUM BLUEPRINT

The five-day Summit ended with the adoption of the "Belum Rainforest Blueprint" as the follow-up actions from the Summit:

1. Increase the tiger population by 20% within four years.
2. Using the concept of payment for ecosystem services through the collaboration with the Federal Government of Malaysia to produce a biodiversity fund that can be used to preserve and properly maintain the Belum-Temengor rainforest complex.
3. Forming a new body such as a Belum Rainforest Council and a Joint Operation Force to improve internal stakeholder management.
4. The importance of youth as key players in the conservation movement.



VOICES OF YOUTH SUMMIT 2016

Voices of Youth was also held in conjunction with the BRainS 2016, from 19th – 22nd October 2016. This programme which was targeted solely at the youth was created with the main objective to give these student leaders an opportunity to brainstorm and lend their "voice" on conservation and sustainable use of the world's tropical rainforests. Conducted in the Belum Adventure Camp situated in the heart of the rainforest, the programme was managed by Green Ranger Malaysia, with a blend of additional programmes such as sharing sessions with world renowned conservationists, outdoor obstacles, and brainstorming sessions. The youths from the programme were given a slot on the last day of the Summit to present their findings and wish list to all participants. Below is the final wish list from the youth of the programme (visual attached).

THE VOICES OF YOUTH WISHLIST

We the youth,

COMMIT to raise public awareness on laws that protect our forests and to report any wildlife trafficking activities. We Commit to educating the public on the the unsustainability of palm oil plantations and hope that clearing of land for this industry is reduced and stop. We commit to use our resources wisely. We commit to practice the buying of second hand books and to donate books after use to reduce the usage and wastage of paper, which affects our forest resources. To raise more awareness on the Belum-Temengor forests, we commit to creating programs and activities in our communities that aim to educate our friends, family and school. At the same time, we also will share our own experiences in Belum with them. We also will commit to stop buying products made from wild animal parts to reduce the demand for poaching; which threatens our forests and its wildlife. Through social media, we will spread information on Belum-Temengor to a wider public.

We **CHALLENGE** the governments to implement reforestation to replace our logged forest habitats. We also challenge them to block access points for poaching activities. More opportunity should be given for students and youth across the country to visit and learn about the flora and fauna of the Belum forests as well as the threats it faces from poaching and logging. We Challenge the Pulau Banding Foundation to organize yearly school visits to Belum. We also wish for Temengor to be gazetted and be provided with more rangers to patrol the forest area and borders. We Challenge the government to make Belum-Temengor a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We challenge the state and federal government to enforce existing laws on forest protection.

Buat pertama kalinya, Pulau Banding Foundation (PBF) dengan kerjasama Kementerian Sumber Asli dan Alam Sekitar (NRE), Kerajaan Negeri Perak, Malaysian Timber Council (MTC), Institut Penyelidikan Perhutanan Malaysia (FRIM), Persatuan Pencinta Alam Malaysia (MNS) dan Belum Conservation Malaysia telah menganjurkan Belum Rainforest Summit 2016 atau dengan ringkasnya, BRainS 2016 pada 17 – 22 Oktober 2016. Persidangan ini turut disokong oleh organisasi penyelidikan perhutanan antarabangsa yang sangat terkenal iaitu International Union of Forest Research Organisation (IUFRO) yang beroperasi di Vienna, Austria, Kementerian Pelancongan dan Kebudayaan Malaysia serta Malaysian Convention and Exhibition Bureau (MyCEB).

Kids Interactive Expedition (K.I.t.E) 2016

20-23 November 2016 | Laketown Adventure Park (LAP), Bukit Merah Laketown Resort, Perak

INTRODUCTION

The Kids Interactive Expedition (K.I.t.E) 2016 took off with a bang at the Bukit Merah Laketown Resort. The event took place from the 20th -23rd of November 2016. This is the third edition of this camp which was previously named Kids Temengor Expedition (K.I.T.E). The name had been change to suit the various venues that the camp may take place in the coming years.

The expedition which is strongly supported by the Ministry of Education Malaysia was officiated by the Director of Co-Curricular and Arts Department, Ministry of Education Malaysia, YBhg Puan Hj Rozainum binti Ahmad.

This year's camp saw some changes on the venue and the activities that were planned for the participants. The first two expeditions were based at the Belum Adventure Camp and the area surrounding the Belum-Temengor Rainforest whilst this year the organisers had changed the venue to Bukit Merah for a new adventure.

A total of 100 participants from primary and secondary schools (10 primary schools and 10 secondary schools) around Peninsular Malaysia took part in this camp. This year, the participants were taken to the Kuala Sepetang Mangrove Education Centre, the charcoal factory in Matang and the Orang Utan Island at Bukit Merah. The four days expedition taught the participants the importance of Mother Nature and how experiments on the flora and fauna are carried out. The goal of this programme is to create awareness on the environment and cultivate the interest of science which in turn will create young scientists of nature. The participants were also fortunate to enjoy some outdoor activities at the Laketown Adventure Park & Nature Education Centre (LAP).

There were four topics of experiments:-

- *Water quality and pollution control*
- *Study of invertebrates (butterflies and leeches)*
- *Flowering plants, shrubs and tree*
- *Mammals*

Lecturers from local universities, who were the mentors, helped and briefed the participants on the processes to carry out experiments. The researchers also participated with the participants in experiments

which took place in the forests or at the lake until late night. This exposure has increased students' confidence in carrying out experiments and recording their findings. Dr Syamsul Khamis, Dr Marina Mohd Top and Mohd Fariz Abdul Aziz from Universiti Putra Malaysia also guided the students to the extent that the best group from Hornbill and Pioneer were able to present their findings to the members of the floor during the closing ceremony.

Participants were also able to listen to a motivational talk by YBhg Dato' Dr. Sheikh Muszaphar Shukor. This talk is to encourage the students to study hard and instil their interest in science. During the closing ceremony, Prof. Carsten F Shroder, a Forestry Lecturer from University of Gottigen, Germany was also invited to give a motivational talk. In his speech, he informed that Malaysia is very fortunate to have forests that housed more than 4,000 types of species (biodiversity) compared to Germany which only have less than 20 species. Hence, he advised the young generation to understand their responsibility to safeguard the forests in Malaysia.

The closing ceremony was officiated by YBhg Dato' Dr. Abdul Rashid Bin Ab Malik, the CEO of Pulau Banding Foundation.

Kem ekspedisi tahunan anjuran Green Ranger Malaysia dengan nama singkatannya K.I.T.E telah dijalankan untuk tahun ketiga pada 20 hingga 23 November 2016. Kem pada tahun ini diberi nama Kids Interactive Expedition (K.I.T.E) ekoran perubahan lokasi kem iaitu di persekitaran Bukit Merah, Perak Darul Ridzuan.

Majlis Perasmian Pembukaan K.I.T.E telah disempurnakan oleh YBhg Puan HjH Rozainum binti Ahmad, Pengarah Bahagian Kokurikulum dan Kesenian, Kementerian Pendidikan Malaysia yang membuktikan sokongan padu beliau terhadap program Green Ranger Malaysia.

- *Mengenalpasti tumbuhan berbunga, tumbuhan renek dan pokok*
- *Mamalia*

Kehadiran mentor, yang merupakan para pensyarah dari universiti-universiti tempatan telah banyak membantu di dalam memberi penerangan tentang langkah-langkah membuat kajian. Para pengkaji juga turut **menyertai** para pelajar sepanjang menjalankan

kajian, samada di hutan mahupun di tasik, sehingga lewat malam. Pendedahan ini memberikan keyakinan kepada para peserta untuk melakukan kajian dan merekodkan hasil/dapatan dari kajian masing-masing. Dr. Syamsul Khamis, Dr. Marina Mohd Top dan Mohd Fariz Abdul Aziz, dari Universiti Putra Malaysia turut membimbing hingga membolehkan wakil dari setiap kumpulan Horbill dan Pioneer membentangkan hasil kajian masing-masing kepada para hadirin semasa Majlis Penutupan.

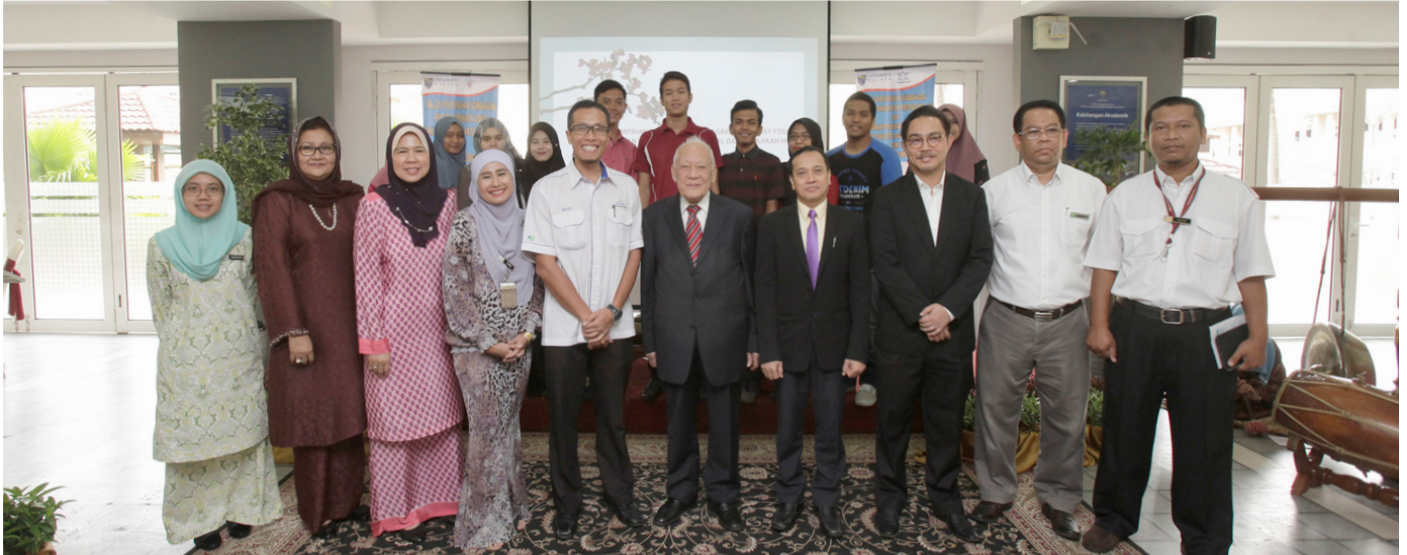

UNFCCC's 22nd Session of Conference of Parties (COP 22) 14- 16 November 2016, Marrakech, Morocco.

Once again Pulau Banding Foundation was given the opportunity to showcase its forest conservation activities at another important international forum; the 22nd UNFCCC Session of the Conference of Parties on Climate Change (COP22) in Marrakech, Morocco. This conference was held from 14-16 November 2016. For PBF, this was the first time it was participating in the COP UNFCCC initiatives. The invitation was extended by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (NRE), Malaysia under its private sector participation initiatives on conservation. PBF made its presentation on its past forest conservation activities as a private sector in the session on REDD+ Day hosted by Malaysia on 14 November 2016. Malaysia was represented by 109 officials and the Malaysian delegation was led by the Honourable Dato Sri Dr. Wan Junaidi Tuanku Jaafar, Minister of Natural Resources and Environment Ministry, Malaysia. This COP 22 meeting in Marrakesh was a follow-up of last year's COP 21 meeting that was held in Paris in which the world came together around a historic Climate Agreement that affirmed the global community's commitment to shift towards a zero-carbon economy. Malaysia with more than 50% of its land still under forest cover played a significant role in this Climate Change Agreement.
